


DEMOLITION NOTES

- 1. ACCESS FOR VEHICLES/TRUCKING OF DEBRIS IS TO BE VIA WELLINGTON LANE
- 2. REMOVE WALLS, PARTITIONS, STRUCTURAL SYSTEMS, MECHANICAL AND ELECTRICAL SERVICES, AND ASSOCIATED ITEMS AS NOTED.
- 3. FINISHES TO BE REMOVED AS REQUIRED TO SUIT NEW PROPOSED REFER TO OWNERS FOR FINISHES.
- 4. DISCONNECT ALL POWER AND ILLUMINATION AS NECESSARY FOR THE COMPLETION OF REMOVAL OPERATIONS.
- 5. ABANDONED SERVICES NOT TO BE EXTENDED OR REUSED TO BE REMOVED.
- 6. DISCONNECT ALL SERVICE PIPING NECESSARY FOR THE COMPLETION OF REMOVAL OPERATIONS.
- 7. CAP AND ABANDON SERVICE LINES NOT TO BE EXTENDED OR REUSED.
- 8. REROUTE SERVICES WHICH MUST BE MAINTAINED. REFER TO PLUMBING AND ELECTRICAL DRAWINGS FOR DETAILS.
- 9. ALL REMOVED EQUIPMENT ITEMS, WALLS. STRUCTURAL, MECHANICAL, ELECTRICAL AND FINISH MATERIALS OTHER THAN OWNERS SALVAGED ITEMS SHALL BE THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE CONTRACTOR AND SHALL BE CAREFUL AND APPROPRIATELY REMOVED FROM THE SITE.
- 10. EXISTING UTILITIES AND SERVICE LINES DISCOVERED DURING REMOVAL OPERATIONS SHALL BE IMMEDIATELY REPORTED TO THE CONTRACTOR.
- 11. PROVIDE SUITABLE PROTECTION FOR ADJACENT EXISTING AREAS BEFORE, DURING AND FOLLOWING REMOVAL AND DEMOLITION OPERATIONS.
- 12. DEBRIS SHALL BE CAREFULLY REMOVED USING ADEQUATELY ENCLOSED CONTAINERS TO PREVENT UNWANTED DEBRIS SPILL.
- 13. NO MATERIAL SHALL BE BURNED, STORED OR SOLD IN EITHER THE BUILDING OR ON THE SITE.
- 14. ALL REMOVED MATERIALS AND DEBRIS, UNLESS IDENTIFIED OTHERWISE, SHALL BECOME THE CONTRACTORS PROPERTY AND SHALL BE REMOVED IMMEDIATELY AND COMPLETELY FROM THE BUILDING AND SITE.

15. LEAVE THE SITE CLEAN AND READY FOR FURTHER CONSTRUCTION













ELECTRICAL NOTES

- 1. ELECTRICAL WIRING PATHS DISPLAYED ARE FOR VISUAL REFERENCE ONLY.
- 2. ALL ELECTRICAL SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE 2014 BERMUDA RESIDENTIAL BUILDING CODE (PRIMARILY BUT NOT LIMITED TO) SECTION 20 ELECTRICAL.
- 3. PROVIDE ONE SMOKE DETECTOR IN EACH ROOM AND ONE IN THE HALL ACCESSING THE BEDROOMS. CONNECT SMOKE DETECTORS TO HOUSE POWER AND MAKE SURE THEY ARE INTERCONNECTED. IF ONE TRIPS THEY ALL WILL SOUND. BATTERY BACKUPS FOR ALL UNITS
- 4. BATHROOMS AND UTILITY ROOMS ARE TO BE VENTED OUTSIDE WITH A FAN THAT IS CAPABLE OF PRODUCING A MINIMUM OF 5 AIR EXCHANGES PER HOUR.
- 5. ELECTRICAL RECEPTACLES IN THE BATHROOM AND KITCHEN ARE TO BE G.F.I OR G.F.I.C PER NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE REQUIREMENTS.



PLUMBING NOTES

- 1. PLUMBING DISTRIBUTION PATHS ARE FOR VISUAL REFERENCE ONLY.
- 2. ALL PLUMBING SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE BRBC (PRIMARILY BUT NOT LIMITED TO) SECTIONS 22, 23, 24 AND 25.
- 3. PLUMBING CONTRACTOR SHALL HAVE THE RESPONSIBILITY OVER SUPPLY DISTRIBUTION.
- 4. D/P 4" DRAIN PIPE (SOIL)
- 5. W/w 3" WASTE WATER PIPE
- 6. 3" VENT
